Overlength Page Charge Agreement

I understand that the free page limit for the IEEE Transactions on Instrumentation and Measurement (IEEE TIM) is as follows:

Regular papers: eight (8) pages

Survey/Review papers: twelve (12) pages

Short papers: one (1) page

Special Issue papers: eight (8) pages, unless stated otherwise by the Special Issue instructions

I, _____ agree, or my organization, _____, agrees, to pay a mandatory overlength page charge of \$265 for each page or fraction thereof beyond the above-mentioned free page limit, to publish the paper originally entitled:

I understand that I will be billed directly by the IEEE after the publication of the paper, should such charges be necessary. I further understand that these overlength charges will not be waived, under any circumstances, by IEEE TIM.

I also understand that the exact number of pages of an accepted paper will only be determined by the IEEE, after IEEE's editing process of that accepted paper, and not before. As an approximation (not exact!), three double-spaced (12-point font, 26 lines per page) typewritten pages will make one printed page. Approximately six single-column figures having a 1:1 aspect ratio will fit on one printed page. Authors may also wish to format their papers using the IEEE double-column format to obtain a closer estimate of the number of pages.

This Overlength Page Charge Agreement MUST be signed by an author in the position of authority whose signature commits him/her or his/her institution to the above terms. This form CANNOT be signed by an author without financial authority, such as most students.
